Key objectives:

This role is part of an ambitious growth for both Tree Aid and Farm Africa, who are both committed to expanding their impact beyond field implementation in the next few years. By investing in policy & advocacy, we are determined to harness our expertise from the ground to inspire and influence systemic changes that will benefit the communities we each serve. As such, the key objective of this role is to create, implement and monitor a jointly-owned national advocacy strategy and action plans for Ethiopia, based on your expertise and current policy context.
